Mode of Classes

For this course most of the teaching and learning activities are conducted in asynchronous mode. This means that students can access recorded lectures, reading materials, presentations, and other learning resources on the LMS at any convenient time, according to their own schedule. This flexibility allows students to learn at their own pace and review the lecture materials whenever required. However, to ensure proper guidance and interaction, some scheduled online sessions with instructors are also arranged in synchronous mode. During these sessions, students can ask questions, discuss course topics, and receive clarification on difficult concepts. Students are encouraged to regularly check the course announcements and schedule on the LMS so that they do not miss these important interactive sessions and other academic activities such as quizzes, assignments, and discussions.

Instructions Regarding Material Access

1. Login to LMS Portal
Always login to the Learning Management System (LMS) using your provided username and password.
2. Access Your Courses
After login, go to the “My Courses” section to see the courses in which you are enrolled.
3. Follow the Course Schedule
Check the course outline and weekly schedule to know when lectures, quizzes, and assignments are planned.
4. Attend Online Lectures
Join live (synchronous) classes through the link provided in your course on LMS.
5. Watch Recorded Lectures
If you miss a live class, you can watch the recorded lecture (asynchronous learning) available in the course section.

6. Download Study Material

All lecture slides, notes, and reading material can be downloaded from the LMS course page.

7. Submit Assignments on Time

Upload assignments through the assignment submission link before the deadline.

8. Participate in Discussion Forums

Use the discussion board/forum to ask questions and interact with your instructor and classmates.

9. Check Announcements Regularly

Always read course announcements for updates about classes, quizzes, or exams.

10. Maintain Internet and Device Readiness

Ensure you have a stable internet connection and a working device (laptop/mobile) before joining the class.

11. Contact Instructor When Needed

If you face any academic issue, contact your course instructor through LMS message or email.
